Law enforcement authorities <u>identified</u> the shooter <u>at the GOP congressional baseball practice</u> as James T. Hodgkinson (above, left) of Belleville, Illinois.

There is a <u>Twitter profile</u> for a James Hodgkinson from Belleville, Illinois. The account was created in January 2014.

The account was little used, but it does suggest the user was deeply interested in politics and was a fan of left-wing personalities such as Bernie Sanders and Ed Schultz. Here are Hodgkinson's three tweets after joining Twitter in 2014.
